Delegate	To give a particular job to someone else, so that they can do it for you.
Off shoring	The practice of outsourcing jobs overseas(to another country) is known as off shoring
Payroll	Payroll is the process of calculating and distributing wages and other payments to the employees by the employer




Keywords and Meanings

Mind Map






Concept of Business Process Outsourcing-BPO

Business Process Outsourcing(BPO) is a process in which

- A company <u>delegates</u> some of its business processes to another party.
- Passes over total control of process to them.
- Makes payment to the party for their job.




Examples of BPO

Back office outsourcing is the delegation of a company's internal business





- I- Achieve revenue increase.




Knowledge Process Outsourcing(KPO)

Knowledge process outsourcing is the delegation of high level tasks to an outside organization, generally off shoring or a different group(possibly in a different geographic location) within the same organization. In BPO, focus is on process expertise, whereas in KPO, focus is on Knowledge(skill) expertise.

Difference Between BPO and KPO

Business Process Outsourcing(BPO)	Knowledge Process Outsourcing(BPO)
Insists for labor and requires less skilled activities	Deals with specialized knowledge based activities
Basic qualification is enough to work in BPO sector	Highly qualified and skilled professionals required
Involvement with the client is low	Involvement with the client is high
Salary of the employee is low	Salary of the employee is high
Examples: Customer care, tele-marketing, sales etc	Examples: Engineers, Doctors, Lawyers etc
